# Trip Report and Final List: **NORTHERN COLOMBIA**

February 10<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup>, 2025

Despite being common at certain elevations, this **Black-cheeked Mountain Tanager** is a stunning bird and we never tired of seeing it.

This short tour was loaded with special birds, incredible landscapes, and great food. It is difficult to beat as a destination, perhaps especially for people looking for a shorter trip. That was the case for some of the participants, but everyone was rewarded with tons of endemics and plenty of other special regional birds. We had a great tour, the tour group was very nice, and everyone got along well; there were plenty of laughs!



We finished the tour with a group photo with the statue of Shakira in Barranquilla, the most famous celebrity of the city.

We started by birding along the coast in Salamanca NP and the deserts of La Guajira, then moved to wet tropical forest near Tayrona NP, and finished up by birding various different elevations of the Santa Marta Mountain range along the San Lorenzo ridge for the last half of the tour.

**LA GUAJIRA (coastal deserts and thornscrub):** The first couple days of the trip had the smell of the ocean all around us as we birded in a few spots along the coast. We kicked off the tour with a visit to Parque Salamanca where we found the very localized endemic **Sapphire-bellied Hummingbird** of which some people doubt its status as a separate species from the similar Sapphire-throated Hummingbird. We were careful to get good views of one individual showing the distinct features.

That morning we also found, as highlights, **Chestnut-winged Chachalaca** (another endemic), **Russet-throated Puffbird**, **Bicolored Conebill**, the super-cute **Chestnut Piculet**, **Golden-green** and **Spot-breasted Woodpeckers**, **Black-crested Antshrike**, and the tiny **American Pygmy Kingfisher**.

That afternoon and the next day we birded along the coastal desert near Riohacha where various iconic birds are present. The most memorable was the colorful **Vermilion Cardinal** which was not particularly easy during our visit, but we did have satisfactory views of a male and close-up views of the female. The past couple of years they had been coming to a feeder, but this year they were a little harder to find.

Other highlights included **Orinocan Saltator**, **American Flamingo**, **Black-faced Grassquit**, **Caribbean Hornero**, **Buffy Hummingbird**, **Red-billed Emerald**, the gorgeous **White-whiskered Spinetail**, **Trinidad Euphonia**, one bright **Scarlet Ibis**, **Northern White-fringed Antwren**, **Glaucous Tanager**, **Rufous-vented Chachalaca** and a very cooperative **Double-striped Thick-knee**. There was also time to look for coastal species, of which we picked up plenty of species of shorebirds, terns, herons, and more.

**TAYRONA NP and surroundings (humid lowland forest):** During this time of year, the indigenous community that lives inside this famous national park, closes the park due to a yearly ritual. This prevented us, again this year, from birding inside it. However, there is good birding in the proximities. We visited two spots that gave us great birding, Gaviotas Road and Villa Maria Trail. Both offered a mix of disturbed and mature secondary humid forest that held various species that we couldn't see elsewhere on the tour.

Among the more memorable birds of this area were **Lance-tailed Manakin**, **White-necked Puffbird**, a surprising **Ruby-topaz Hummingbird**, **White-vented Plumeleteer**, **Black-headed Tody-Flycatcher**, **Collared Aracari**, and the hulking **Crimson-crested Woodpecker**, to name a few.

**THE SANTA MARTA MOUNTAINS (various elevations):** for the second half of the trip we visited the famous Sierra Nevada de Santa Marta, an isolated mountain range that towers very high above the nearby Caribbean Sea, giving us a chance to bird a great range of elevations. For three nights we stayed at the new Mountain House Lodge to explore not only the mid-elevation forest where this lodge sits, but also the higher portions of the San Lorenzo Ridge too. Later we moved for one night to Minca, located in the drier foothills.

The highest areas that we visited were home to tons of targets that we needed to find in one morning. We managed to pick up almost all the key species, starting pre-dawn with the difficult **Santa Marta Screech-Owl**, then **Santa Marta Antpitta**, **Sierra Nevada Antpitta**, **Santa Marta Parakeet**, **Streak-capped** and **Rusty-headed Spinetails**, **Hermit Wood-Wren**, **Santa Marta Warbler**, **Yellow-crowned Redstart**, **Black-cheeked Mountain Tanager**, **White-tailed Starfrontlet**, and not only did we see, but we even photographed a **Brown-rumped Tapaculo**. We failed to spot a **Santa Marta Bush-Tyrant** that was singing from a hidden perch in a distant treetop and we could not locate the thornbill (which no one else had been seeing over the past week).

The mid-elevations produced lots of other great birds and plenty of endemics, namely **Santa Marta Antbird**, **Santa Marta Brushfinch**, **Sierra Nevada Brushfinch**, **Santa Marta Blossomcrown**, **Santa Marta Woodstar**, **Santa Marta Tapaculo**, **Santa Marta Foliage-gleaner**, **White-tipped Quetzal**, **White-lored Warbler**, **Golden-breasted Fruiteater**, **Lined Quail-Dove**, **Southern Emerald-Toucanet**, **Groove-billed Toucanet**, **Gray-throated Leaftosser**, **Black-headed Tanager**, and a personal favorite of mine, the cute **Rusty-breasted Antpitta**.

I have to mention that the accommodation and feeders at Mountain House were fantastic. This small, family owned lodge is comfortable and the people that own and run the lodge are very nice. Food was good and super early packed breakfasts and lunches were provided with a smile and no complaints at all. Hummers were particularly good here with plenty of **Crowned Woodnymphs**, **Brown** and **Lesser Violetears**, plus a lonely **Lazuline Sabrewing**. It also attracted colorful **Blue-naped Chlorophonias**, striking **Bicolored Wrens**, and bright **Yellow-backed Orioles**.

Finally, we moved downslope to bird the strikingly drier foothills of the Santa Martas. This area is home to a few special birds that are not found elsewhere on the tour. My favorites seen during the afternoon and morning we had here were **Golden-winged Sparrow**, **Scaled Piculet**, **Military Macaw**, and the always difficult (despite being very vocal) **Rosy Thrush-Tanager**. Apart from those we also found a bunch of other great birds like a roosting **Black-and-white Owl** (which was selected as one of the top 3 birds of the tour by the participants), **Chestnut-capped Warbler**, **Golden-headed Manakin**, **Cinereous Becard**, and the prolific songster **Rufous-and-white Wren**.

We returned to the city a bit early to avoid the potentially problematic road closures and traffic in Barranquilla caused by the Carnaval holiday, which is a huge deal here. Roads would be blocked for parades and concerts by dozens of artists, including the even Shakira herself. We were happy to visit the Malecon where the municipality had built a statue to this great artist who donates lots of money for social programs for people in need in this corner of the world through her own foundation. The area is also the best place to find the much wanted **Northern Screamer**, which we saw a couple hundred meters away from the statue. What a way to finish!
