

Malaysia: Birding the Peninsula 2025

Located at the heart of the Sundaland biome, Peninsula Malaysia shares a rich variety of birds with Sumatra, Java, Borneo and even the Himalayas. This tour is built around two significantly different biomes, montane evergreen forest where pseudo-Himalayan species can be found, and lowland rainforest that shares similar species with the Greater Sunda islands. Over the course of a week-long tour, we spent our time birding at three major birdwatching sites starting with Kuala Selangor Nature Park, then Fraser's Hill and finished off at Taman Negara National Park (Kuala Tahan). The total of 205 bird species were recorded throughout the tour including some of Malaysia's most sought-after rarities such as Malaysian Rail-babbler, Marbled Wren-Babbler and Rusty-naped Pitta.

Day 1: 29 June – Kuala Selangor Nature Park to Fraser's Hill

We were picked up from Sama Sama Hotel KLIA by our driver at 6:00 AM then headed towards Kuala Selangor where we would do a half-day birding in the morning. After a simple breakfast near the Kuala Selangor Nature Park, we started exploring the lush mangrove forest within the area. Some highlights of the morning included **Mangrove Blue Flycatcher, Mangrove Whistler, Asian Tit (AKA Cinereous Tit), Stork-billed Kingfisher**, and 3 species of woodpeckers (**Common Flameback, Sunda Pygmy** and **Laced Woodpecker**). We were also

treated with excellent views of the globally near-threatened **Selangor Silvered Langur**, which proved to be abundant at the nature park. Other significant wildlife sightings include several species of mudskippers, Littoral Whiptail Skink and Common Water Monitor. After lunch, we then drove up to Fraser's Hill where we arrived in the late afternoon. Our first day at Fraser's Hill already proved to be very productive with a big flock of **Long-tailed Broadbills, Sultan Tit, Sunda Cuckoo, Black-and-crimson Oriole, Fire-tufted and Black-browed Barbet, Malayan Partridge, Collared Babbler**, as well as **White-thighed Surili** and Southern Pig-tailed Macaque, all showing superbly. Just before sunset, we also got to see a pair of **Helmeted Hornbills**, one of the rarest hornbills in Asia. At night, we did a short walk around the hotel and came across a beautiful **Sabah Bamboo Pitviper** and several calling Mountain Scops Owls.

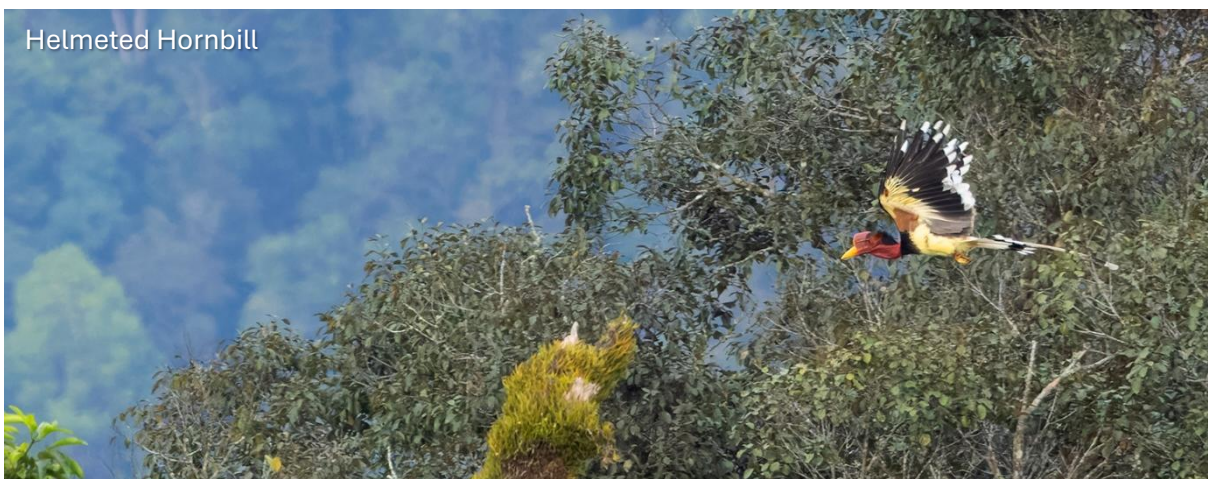
Day 2: 30 June – Fraser's Hill

We started our day by going into a forest trail where we were rewarded with prolonged views of a duetting pair of **Marbled Wren-Babblers**, one of the rarest species of babblers in Malaysia. We enjoyed superb views of a bird singing completely in the open for nearly half an hour before we decided to move on. While in the trail, we also heard a Rusty-naped Pitta but failed to see it. Other highlights of the morning include a

surprisingly **confiding Blyth's Hawk-Eagle, Rufous-browed Flycatcher and Pygmy Cupwing**. In the afternoon, we decided to join the flock of photographers after learning that a **Rusty-naped Pitta** had been showing recently. After a bit of waiting, we finally got to see a female **Rusty-naped Pitta** at the stakeout. There were also other birds coming to the same area including Rufous-browed and Little Pied Flycatcher, **Lesser Shortwing, Large Niltava** and **White-tailed Robin**. We then drove down to The Gap area to look for some lowland and foothill species. Along the way, we came across several new birds for the trip such as **Scaly-breasted Bulbul**, Buff-vented Bulbul and Hume's White-eye. At The Gap, we were treated with excellent views of the typically shy **Black Laughingthrush**, as well as a beautiful male **Rufous-collared Kingfisher**. We also heard a calling **Bamboo Woodpecker** and got a brief view of the bird in flight. Just before it got completely dark, we were also excited to see many **Malaysian Eared-Nightjars** flying around above the forest.

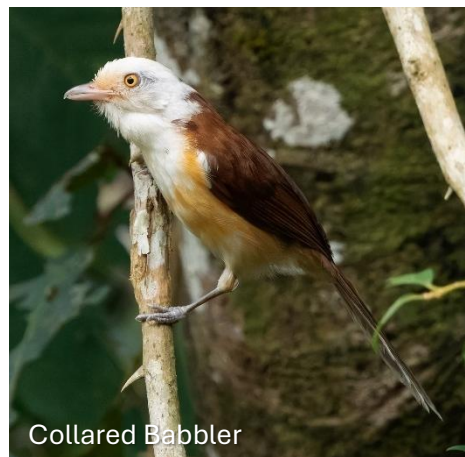

Day 3: 1 July – Fraser's Hill

We started birding around the clock tower where we enjoyed seeing the colorful **Silver-eared Mesia** along with some other birds like **Chestnut-capped Laughingthrush**, **Long-tailed Sibia**, **Streaked Spiderhunter** and **Mountain Fulvetta**. We also came across two calling **Malayan Whistling-Thrushes** but only managed to get a quick glimpse of one bird. Other highlights of the morning include the range-restricted **Malayan Laughingthrush**, **Long-tailed Broadbill**, **Red-headed Trogon**, **Greater Yellownap**, **Rufous-bellied Swallow**, **Long-billed Spiderhunter** and **Collared Owlet**. In the afternoon, we revisited the pitta stakeout and got to see the **Rusty-naped Pitta** again. We also had better and more prolonged views of the **Malayan Partridge**, **Banded Woodpecker**, **Blue-winged Minla** and **Malayan Cuckooshrike**.

Day 4: 2 July – Fraser's Hill to Taman Negara

We spent the morning birding at Fraser's Hill before driving north to Taman Negara National Park where we would stay for the next 3 nights. We were able to add some more species on our final morning at Fraser's Hill such as **Red Junglefowl**, **Hill Blue Flycatcher** and **Silver-breasted Broadbill**. It took us several hours of driving until we finally reached the jetty where we would cross over the Tembeling River to our accommodation, Mutiara Taman Negara located within the park's pristine lowland forest. Our brief evening walk along the Swamp Loop trail yielded several interesting birds and wildlife such as **Blue-rumped Parrot**, **Little Gren-Pigeon**, **Sooty-capped Babbler**, **Chestnut-winged Babbler**, **Lesser Oriental Chevrotain** and a nesting pair of **Black-naped Monarchs**.

Day 5: 3 July – Taman Negara

After breakfast, we spent our morning birding along the forest edge, then Tahan Hide and into the Swamp Loop trail. The morning was extremely productive with a long list of great birds such as **Checker-throated Woodpecker**, **Crested Jayshrike**, **Green Broadbill**, **Crested Partridge**, **Malayan Crested Fireback**, **Large Wren-Babbler** and a pair of **Malaysian Rail-babblers**, which was undoubtedly the biggest highlight of the morning. Even though the afternoon was not as birdy as in the morning, we were still able to see some good birds such as **Rufous-backed Dwarf-Kingfisher**, **Buff-necked Woodpecker**, **Rufous-chested Flycatcher**, **Rufous-crowned Babbler** and again, a big flock of **Malayan Crested Firebacks**.



Day 6: 4 July – Taman Negara

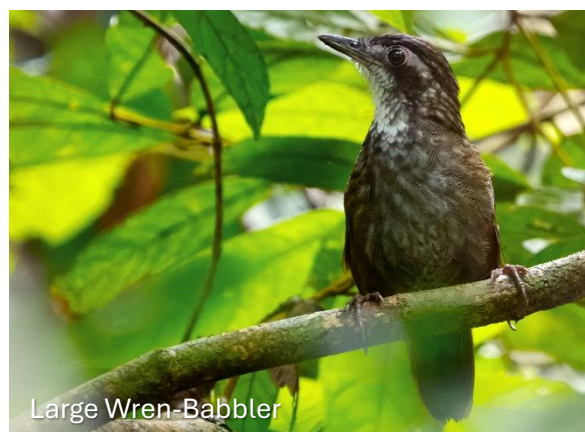
We pretty much repeated the same itinerary as yesterday. Our main target was the elusive **Garnet Pitta** which we still had not seen nor heard yet. To our surprise, we almost instantly heard a single bird calling once we reached the Swamp Loop trail in the morning. After some effort, we finally got to see the stunning jewel-like bird as it popped up to sing from exposed perches right in front of us for several minutes. Other significant sightings that we had throughout the day included **Malayan Black Magpie**, **Black-bellied Malkoha**, **Orange-backed Woodpecker**, **Banded and Black-and-yellow Broadbill**, **White-necked Babbler** and a family of **Diard's Trogons**. A brief night walk along the boardwalk trail also rewarded us with stunning views of a **Gould's Frogmouth** right before it started to rain.

Our final morning at Taman Negara was mainly focused on looking for the Malayan Banded-Pitta. However, we didn't see nor hear any despite our effort. We still got to see some good birds before we left such as the same **Garnet Pitta**, **Rufous-collared Kingfisher**, **Rufous-winged Philentoma** and **Rufous-bellied Eagle**. We left Taman Negara around noon then headed back to Kuala Lumpur where we said our goodbyes at the airport, concluding the around for Peninsula Malaysia.
